

Lucy Security Privacy Policy

Log Data

Cookies

The Lucy Security website uses "cookies" to collect information to help us improve our Service. You have the option to either accept or refuse these cookies and know when a cookie is being sent to your computer. If you choose to refuse our cookies, you may not be able to use some portions of our Service.
